

1. POLICIES

- 1.1 A Hospitality Special Event Licence authorizes a liquor agency or a liquor supplier to possess, store and provide liquor at their premises for the purpose of hosting individuals, groups, and organizations for events such as facility tours, educational seminars, meetings and media conferences.
- 1.2 A Hospitality Special Event Licence will only be issued by the AGLC.
- 1.3 The licensee is responsible for ensuring compliance with all legislation, policies and requirements governing the sale and consumption of liquor.
- 1.4 The licensee must have the legal right to occupy and control the licensed area for the duration of the events (i.e. ownership or rental agreement).
- 1.5 A Hospitality Special Event Licensee must comply with the General Special Event Licence Policies and Guidelines.
- 1.6 The fee for a Hospitality Special Event Licence is \$10.
- 1.7 A Hospitality Special Event Licence is in effect for one year unless cancelled by the AGLC.
- 1.8 Liquor must be purchased from a Class D licensee. Records of liquor purchases must be maintained.
- 1.9 The sale of liquor is not permitted under a Hospitality Special Event Licence.
