

**1. POLICIES**

- 1.1 An Industrial Use Special Event Licence authorizes the licensee to possess, store and use liquor in the licensed premises for the purposes of an industrial, mechanical, food processing or manufacturing business.
- 1.2 An Industrial Use Special Event Licence will only be issued by the AGLC.
- 1.3 The applicant must disclose the specific use of the liquor on the application form.
- 1.4 The application for an Industrial Use Special Event Licence must include a copy of the business licence.
- 1.5 The licensee is responsible for ensuring compliance with all legislation, policies and requirements governing the consumption of liquor.
- 1.6 The fee for an Industrial Use Special Event Licence is \$10.
- 1.7 An Industrial Use Special Event Licence is in effect for one year unless cancelled by the AGLC.
- 1.8 Liquor must be purchased from a Class D licensee. Ethyl alcohol must be purchased direct from suppliers. Records of liquor purchases must be maintained.
- 1.9 The sale of liquor is not permitted under an Industrial Use Special Event Licence.
