## Canadian Food Inspection Agency to recall liquor product

*Edmonton...* Albertans are advised not to consume certain Woody's Mexican Lime Alcoholic Vodka Beverage as they may contain glass particles. Consumers may return the product to the original location of purchase for a refund.

The recall includes Woody's Mexican Lime Alcoholic Vodka Beverage products with lot numbers **BB014/06/13** and **BB22/08/13**. In support of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency's recall notification, the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission is advising liquor licensees across the province, including liquor stores, bars, pubs, clubs, lounges and restaurants to remove these products from their shelves and serving stocks. Licensees are required to return the product to the main liquor warehouse.

Woody's Mexican Lime beverages are sold in packages of four 330 ml. bottles. Lot numbers can be found below the neck of each individual bottle. View the product [photo](#) for more details.
