## **All Woody's liquor products in glass bottles being recalled**

*Edmonton...* The Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (AGLC) is calling for all types of Woody's Alcoholic Vodka Beverages to be removed from sale across the province after glass particles were found in some bottles in Manitoba and Ontario. This is an expansion of last week's recall of Woody's brand Mexican Lime Alcoholic Vodka Beverage.

The products being recalled are:

Woody's Pink Grapefruit	Woody's Mexican Lime
Woody's Orange Light	Woody's Raspberry Light
Woody's Pineapple & Grapefruit	Woody's Refresher (Cream Soda)
Woody's Sasparilla (Root Beer)	Woody's Cola Brew
Woody's Blackcurrant & Apple	Pomtini Vodka & Pomegranate Cooler
Appletini	Orangetini Orange Vodka Cooler

In the interest of customer safety, the AGLC is also advising liquor stores, bars, pubs, clubs, lounges and restaurants to remove these products from their shelves and serving stocks. Licensees are required to return the product to the main liquor warehouse.

These beverages are sold in packages of four 330 ml. bottles. Consumers may return the product to the original location of purchase for a refund.
