MINIMUM LIQUOR PRICES AND SERVICE LIMITS

Effective **August 1, 2008**, all liquor licensees in Alberta must follow new policies regarding liquor to be consumed on premises.

BEVERAGE

MINIMUM PRICE

Spirits/Liqueurs (e.g. rye, vodka)	\$2.75/oz.
Wine (by the glass)	\$.35/oz.
Draft Beer	\$.16/oz.
Beer/Cider/Cooler (bottle or can)	\$2.75 each

Minimum price means the lowest price at which a licensee may sell liquor at any time, even during drink specials, promotions and happy hours.

SERVICE LIMITS

Drink Specials & Happy Hours must end by 8 p.m.

(At which time all drinks must be sold at the regular menu price)

After 1 a.m. - Staff are not allowed to serve a patron more than two standard size drinks per order.

After 1 a.m. - Patrons cannot have more than two standard size drinks in their possession, either in their hands or on their table.

Standard size means 1 oz. Spirits/Liqueurs, 12 oz. Can/Bottle/Draft beer and 5 oz. Wine
