Liquor Bulletin

Farmers' and Artisan Markets

August 17, 2020

This bulletin is to advise interested stakeholders of a new addition to Class B liquor licence policy.

Effective August 17, 2020 farmers' and artisan markets may be eligible for a Class B liquor licence if they meet specified conditions. Some the key conditions are as follows:

- the market is approved by Alberta Agriculture and Forestry and/or AGLC;
- the market operates on a year round or seasonal (three month minimum) basis;
- the liquor service area is clearly defined and equipped with a beverage preparation area; and
- food service is available.
